Warner Beach South Code Of Conduct Form

1. Acknowledge that I have read the Code of Conduct as extracted from the Constitution of the WBSNW, and fully understand the terms thereof.
2. Acknowledge that I have chosen to be a member of WBSNW and voluntarily participate in patrolling activities.
3. Acknowledge further, that the WBSNW is not a corporate entity established by or under any law nor does it have juristic personality.
4. Indemnify the aforesaid WBSNW, its committee and other members, in respect of any criminal or civil liability, against any costs, claims, suits or damages howsoever arising directly or indirectly from any intentional act or omission or any negligence on my part

Code of Conduct

1. This Code of Conduct and the Constitution of WBSNW shall be binding on all members of WBSNW.
2. Members of WBSNW must at all times act in a non-violent manner. No member may take the law into his or her own hands irrespective of circumstances.
3. No member of WBSHW shall display racism, sexism or any other form of discrimination towards any member and any other person.

4. When on patrol a WBSNW member may only use “minimum force”, as described in the Criminal Procedure Act No. 51 of 1977 to secure the arrest of the perpetrator of an offence and no intimidation in whatever form may be used in the communities where such patrols will be taking place.
5. No member of WBSNW may when patrolling carry any weapon(s) perceived to be dangerous that could inflict serious bodily harm and or damage to property; this shall include dangerous weapon as defined in the Constitution of WBSNW. Only weapons for sole purpose of self-defence as approved by the Provincial Commissioner South African Police Services.
6. No person under the age of 18 years may participate in any patrol.
7. Any WBSNW member who intends taking a firearm on patrol must declare such to the local South African Police Services before taking such firearm on patrol.
8. Members of WBSHW may not divulge any confidential or privileged information that they may have acquired as a result of their membership of WBSNW.
9. Any member of WBSNW found to be making public statements and or addressing the media as a spokesperson for WBSNW without the explicit authority from the Executive Committee of WBSNW duly mandating that member to act for and on behalf of WBSNW shall be guilty of a serious offence, resulting in the immediate suspension of the member pending expulsion subject to full investigation and decision on the matter.
10. No member of WBSNW may accept any payment, commission or gratuity in connection with his or her membership of WBSNW, except after being duly authorized to do so by the Executive Committee of WBSNW.
11. No member of WBSNW may exploit his or her membership of WBSNW for personal advantage or benefit.
12. Members of WBSNW must at all times act in a manner that will uphold and promote the aims and objective of WBSNW as highlighted in WBSNW’s Constitution and this Code of Conduct.
